L'Hospitalet City Council, and those entities and organizations that wish to collaborate with us. With the support of the TWIRLING FEBD COMMISSION.



Due to the great success of participation in the Open in previous years, we want to inform you that we have decided to extend the competition by 1 more day.

We want all clubs to have the opportunity to participate but the capacity to accept registrations is limited, for this reason the deadline for submitting registrations will be strictly respected, so those clubs that are interested in participating must confirm their attendance within the indicated deadlines.

As a novelty and officially, with the desire that our Open be a window where any group is visualized, this year we will add inclusive sport for athletes with Down syndrome.

The reasons that move us to include this new category of competition are, among others, the existence of athletes with this condition in various clubs and that is why we want to include them.

Because playing sports is the best way to normalize different abilities in adolescent children.

Other objectives are those listed below:

- Maintain good health.
- Improve psychomotor skills
- Help the learning process.
- Achieve personal recognition
- Raise the level of self-esteem.

For all these reasons, this year for now, we will open a category called DIVERSITY, where athletes of both sexes will be able to compete in a single age category in the Freestyle specialty.

Your registration will be completely free and will be done through the official forms.

The performance times, regardless of age, will be 1.30 min., maximum, without having a minimum performance time.

The coach may assist his/her athlete on the court at any time, as well as suspend his/her performance if he/she considers it appropriate.

Like the rest of the specialties and categories, the winners will receive their corresponding medal or diploma.

I hope it is accepted by all the other clubs and athletes and we encourage you to enjoy these athletes who can surely teach us many things.



1. GENERALITIES

This International Open will be governed in general by these rules and by the competition code of the WBTF/IBTF and the Twirling Commission of the FEBD.

Those Spanish or foreign clubs that are interested in taking part in it and do not have said Code, may request it by e-mail to the organization. However, there are some variations that we detail below.

All documentation will be shared with each club through a folder on DRIVE.

Registrations must be completed and uploaded to your DRIVE before 02/30th./24, the deadline for registrations. clubtwirlinghospitalet@gmail.com

The clubs that wish to participate must upload some information about the club to their DRIVE along with the registrations:

- Club logo
- Name of the president
- Name of the coach
- 1 photo of the president
- 1 photo of the entrant
- 1 photo of each athlete

The organization will prepare a magazine-program to publicize the event.

Participating clubs will receive 1 unit of the magazine – program for free.

During the competition the facility will have a bar-restaurant service.

All participants will receive a credential, which they must carry with them during the duration of the competition, 1 Badge (credential).

Each club will receive 2 extra badges for free (President + Coach)

Clubs may request more extra badges (only for coaches), if they wish, but they must pay $\underline{\mathbf{e15}}$ for each extra badge.

AGE CALCULATION:

- Pairs: The age of the older component will be taken as a reference.
- Teams: The age of the members will be added and the result will be divided by the number of members of the team. The resulting sum will determine the category.
- Groups: The age of the members will be added and the result will be divided by the number of members of the group. The resulting sum will determine the category.

3. PARTICIPATION BY CLUB

Registration will be free, so each club can present the exercises they want in each specialty, level and category.

4. JUDGES

The competition will be scored by a professional jury made up of a minimum of 3 Judges per table, since the competition will be held alternately between age categories.

All Judges must be qualified to judge with the WBTF/FEBD system.

If any participating country wishes to contribute a judge to the competition, it must notify it well in advance. (Maximum 1 judge per participating country).

These judges must have full knowledge of the WBTF/FEBD scoring system.

The organization will take care of all your meals and will defray the cost of your hotel stay.

The judges of the competition will meet one week before the ON-LINE competition in the afternoon/evening before the start of the competition. The meeting will be directed by a Spanish Judge with a degree from the WBTF.

5. AWARDS

All clubs will receive:

• 1 Participation Cup or Trophy.

All participants will receive:

• 1 participation medal.

The first 6 classified in each specialty, category and level, will receive:

- 1 Medal
- 1 Certificate
- Teams and groups will receive 1 cup

The winning club of the Open will receive a trophy that will accredit it as the absolute winner of the Open 2024

The calculation to determine the winning club of the Open will be established by accumulation of points, for each of the exercises presented.

6. ORDER OF APPARENCE

The order of performance will be given by a previous draw, carried out by the organization.



11. COSTUME

Male / Female:

The costumes are totally free, but participants must remember that it is a SPORTS event. Any fabric and color is allowed.

- The shoes can be of any color. They can be Twirling, gymnastics, jazz or dance.
- In the locker room, any ornament is allowed except wire or fasteners with wires (for security).
- The use of any wall lamp is allowed in the hair.
- Hats or caps are not allowed on the head. No color lacguers are allowed on the hair.
- The use of watches, bracelets, chains, rings is prohibited.
- Only earrings such as stones, pearls, or similar are allowed. Hanging earrings are not allowed.
- For safety, fantasy makeup on the face (sequins, stones or drawings) is NOT allowed.

12. <u>DEFINITION OF TERMS:</u>

Walkovers can be front or back.

- Standard Reception (refers to type of catch) Vertical or Horizontal RH or LH catch or RH or LH grab.
- *Standard Release* Vertical RH or LH thumb toss. Vertical RH or LH backhand toss or Horizontal, RH or LH forward or reverse.
- *Major Body Moves*: A move that requires significant control, flexibility, strength, amplitude and extension. This classification includes any body move desired and includes moves such as: Illusions, walkovers, leaps, or jumps (of any type), sauté arabesque, attitude, grand battement, sauté de basque, tour jeté, cabriole, forward or reverse. These moves will be approximately 3 or more counts in duration.
- *Minor Body Moves:* A move that does not require significant control, flexibility, strength, amplitude, or extension and additionally does not require horizontal or vertical reorientation to the baton (no body rotations <turns>) or maneuvering the body upside down (illusions, bows, etc). These moves will be approximately 2 counts in duration. This classification includes moves such as: hop, skip, chassé, piqué, step-step, and coupé, sauté. This category will often be used as preparation or follow through movements. *Refer to the definition of terms not defined in this chart*

ATTENTION: The chaine' turn is in the same classification as spin. Ex. Single chaine turn = 1 spin; double chaine turn = 2 spins

14. SCORE SISTEM

Step # 1 The classification system will be used by each Judge (not by scores), that is, each judge will issue a score that will be noted in column No. 1 to determine their own classification. That will be the INITIAL score. Then in column No. 2 the penalties to be deducted from the initial score will be noted. In column no. 3 we will have the final score (initial score minus penalty)

Step # 3 Once all the judges have their own classification, proceed to:

- Add the score of all the judges (for possible ties) column no 5
- Add the points by classification, column no 6

The sum of points from column no. 6 will determine the final classification (column no. 7) How? The exercise with the fewest points will receive the first place in the classification and so on, until the exercise with the most points will receive the last place in the classification.

However, any exercise that receives a majority of first places will determine the first place winner.

Step #4 - When an exercise does not get a majority of first place finishes and there is a TIE for place points, we will rely on the total numerical total score from all judges.

The highest total score (sum of points from all judges) breaks the tie and determines the ranking.

Step # 5 - In the event that one or more exercises obtain the same points in column No. 6, the tie will be broken.

How?: Column No. 5 will be reviewed and the exercise with the highest score will be the one that will occupy the highest place in the classification. (See example in the following graph in red color)

The tie will only be maintained in the case of both scores (those in column No. 5 and column No. 6) being the same. In this case there will be 2 sixth positions.

If this happens between the first 3 positions and 2 second positions coincide, there will be a first place, two second positions and there will be no third position, a fourth position will be directly announced.

15. IMAGE RIGTHS RELEASE

All participants, both over 18 years of age and under 18 years of age, when registering through the club they represent and to which they belong, will automatically authorize the organization of the championship to take images of the act: (The concept "image" includes video, still photography or other means of capture, in digital, paper or other format, and any means of recording or reproducing the captured images can be used), whose purpose will be exclusively the public or private dissemination of the act.

16. CLAIMS

1. CLAIMS FOR PENALTIES

Only and exclusively can claims be made during the competition for penalties (baton drops / content restrictions).

To claim for a penalty (baton drops / content restriction), the claiming Club, through its president or technicians, must submit a letter to the Competition Director indicating the possible error of the penalty.

It is allowed to claim, only, for a penalty on athletes of the claiming Club or for any other athlete that affects the classification of the first 6 places.



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Once the claim has been filed, the Competition Director and the President of the Panel of Judges will review the video to verify the possibility of errors.

The claim will be resolved throughout the competition by the penalty judge, the Director of the Competition and the President of the Jury.

The resolution of the claim will be announced in the same delivery of results.

2. DETECTION OF AN ERROR IN THE TABULATION

In the event that, at the time of submitting the tabulations, a Club detects an error in the tabulation that alters the final classification, such as an incorrect sum or a numerical error, an e-mail can be sent to clubtwirlinghospitalet@gmail.com so that be modified.
